

AWARD PRESENTATIONS

THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA IS APPLICABLE FOR ALL AWARD PRESENTATIONS

Annual Presentation Dinner:

All Clubs MUST be present and represented by a Club Official to qualify for the receipt of any Award at the Presentation Dinner or other such event arranged by the Management Committee.

Failure to attend will result is disqualification for any such award. Clubs are not allowed to nominate any person connected with another Club to receive such award on their behalf.

Monthly Awards

All awards are to be presented by a Member of the Management Committee or League Officer to the recipient 15 minutes prior to kick off. The presentation should be done on the pitch and an announcement made over the public-address system. The awards will be made a.s.a.p. after notification has been received by the League Secretary, this may be before they are made public and will normally be done at the next available HOME fixture (subject to the availability of Committee Members/Officers). Where possible the Club concerned will be contacted as they are required to forward a photograph of the presentation to the League Media Team by email (mediateam@nwcfl.com). In the event of not being notified, it does not in any way detract from the Club and recipient's responsibility.

When sending in a photograph for publication on the league website, can clubs please ensure that the photograph is sent in landscape format and not portrait, and should be at least 1024 x 768 pixels, in order to be used on the League website.

Any recipient not appearing for the presentation or refusing the award will forfeit the award and the Club will be charged with Bringing the League into Disrepute. In that circumstance, the Club may be charged with the Management Committee Members travelling expenses.
